ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Public Employee Labor Relations Board after Director Griego issued a letter dismissing the complaint for failure to cure a deficiency within the time allotted by the Director. No parties were present to address the dismissal and no objection or request for review has been received.


At its regularly scheduled meeting on November 14, 2017, by a 2-0 vote (Chair Westbrook being absent), the Board being sufficiently advised finds:

1. The complaint is deficient because it fails to adequately specify what provisions of the PEBA were violated; and
2. Petitioner did not amend the complaint within the time allotted.

THEREFORE THE BOARD ratifies Director Griego's decision to dismiss the case.


Dear Ms. Cox and Ms. Brown:
