Certification of Representation

The undersigned hereby certifies that AFSCME Council 18 (Union) has demonstrated sufficient support among the Town of Taos (Town) employees in the unit described as follows such that it should be recognized as the exclusive bargaining representative for those employees:

All blue collar and white collar employees of the Town of Taos except those in the Police and Fire Departments and excluding Probationary, Managerial, Confidential, or Supervisory Employees.

The undersigned makes this certification based on the following:

 By a Petition filed May 7, 2014, the Union notified the Town of Taos that it was prepared to demonstrate sufficient support among employees in the unit for its recognition as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for those employees.

 On May 8, 2014 the Board's Executive Director determined that the Petition was facially valid and that a preliminary review demonstrated a sufficient

showing of interest to proceed toward an election.

 On May 22, 2014, the District provided a copy of a unit employee list. That list showed that there were 94 employees in the Unit thereby confirming the preliminary finding of sufficiency. An updated list was submitted July 7, 2014.

On July 1, 2014, the PELRB issued an Election Order (11-PELRB-2014)

calling for an election to be held July 10, 2014.

5. The election took place as called for in the Order immediately followed by a ballot count. The election results were: 65 ballots cast out of a total of 77 eligible voters. Therefore, more than 40% of the eligible voters cast ballots. 38, a majority of the ballots cast, were in favor of representation by the Union and 25 were not in favor of representation by the Union. Accordingly, the undersigned hereby certifies that the Union has demonstrated that it has majority support in the Unit and it is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative for the Unit described above.
