ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Public Employee Labor Relations Board (“Board”) on the request of the Executive Director, Thomas Griego for Board review on August 13, 2019.

The Board being sufficiently advised finds by a vote of 3-0 the following:

1. On June 14, 2019 the Executive Director wrote to the Superintendent of Loving Schools informing him that according to information then available, the local labor management relations board authorized by a Resolution enacted in 2009 and approved by this Board on July 2, 2009 (PELRB 201-09), no longer existed.
2. Further research determined that on October 21, 2014 the Loving Municipal School Board “dissolved” its local board and recognized that “the State of New Mexico Labor Relations Board will assume jurisdictional authority in matters relating to the Public Employees Bargaining Act and any filings related to any collective bargaining agreement.”
3. In November of 2014 the rescission of the Resolution was to be reviewed by the PELRB but it does not appear that any action was taken by the Board as a result of the rescission.
4. On June 14, 2019 the Executive Director wrote to the Superintendent of Loving Schools proposing revocation of its prior Resolution approval and by email dated June 26, 2019, counsel for the Loving Schools responded that subject to its right

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to seek certification of a local board in the future, the Loving School Board does not object to revocation of this Board's prior approval of the 2009 resolution.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that this Board's July 2, 2009 approval of the Loving School District Labor Management Relations Resolution shall be, and is hereby,

REVOKED in accordance with §10 of the PEBA and NMAC 11.21.5.14.
