ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Public Employee Labor Relations Board (“Board”) on the County of Los Alamos (“County”) Objections to the Board’s Recommendations and Order and the Board’s denial of the County’s application for approval of a local ordinance, dated January 15, 2021. After review of the objections, hearing oral argument, and being otherwise advised, the Board voted 3-0 to dismiss the County’s objections as moot. The Board finds:

1. The Board’s Executive Director, Thomas Griego, held a hearing on the County’s ordinance compliance with § 10 of the Public Employee Bargaining Act on January 27, 2021.
2. The recommendation by the Executive Director after that hearing was to conditionally approve the County’s ordinance and that recommendation was on the Board’s agenda for further hearing on February 9, 2021.
3. At the same February 9, 2021 meeting, where oral argument was heard on this matter, argument was also heard on approval of the County’s application for approval of its ordinance. The Board voted to conditionally approve the County’s ordinance.

IT IS ORDERED that the County’s objections are **DISMISSED**.
