ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Public Employee Labor Relations Board on a Petition by Communication Workers of America ("CWA") for certification of a new bargaining unit. At its regularly scheduled meeting on March 6, 2018, Director Griego provided the Board with the certified results of the election held on February 16, 2018. The election results established majority support for representation by the CWA. The Board being sufficiently advised finds with a vote of 3-0:

- 1. The election results complied with 11.21.2.1 et seq. NMRA;
- 2. 40% of eligible voters participated in the election; and
- 3. The majority of votes supported representation by CWA.

THEREFORE THE BOARD orders Director Griego to issue certification of representation of the Third Judicial District Attorney's Office by CWA.

The undersigned hereby certifies that Communications Workers of America (Union) has demonstrated a sufficient basis for recognition as the exclusive bargaining representative for those employees in the following bargaining unit comprised of employees of the Third Judicial District Attorney's Office:

Trial Attorneys, Assistant Trial Attorneys, Senior Trial Attorneys and Deputy District Attorneys, excluding All Probationary, Managerial, Confidential, or Supervisory Employees as defined by the PEBA.

The undersigned makes this certification based on the following:

- By a Petition filed November 22, 2017 the Union informed the Third Judicial
 District Attorney's Office that it was prepared to demonstrate sufficient support for
 its recognition as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for certain
 employees.
- 2. On November 22, 2017 the Board's Executive Director determined that the Petition was facially valid and that a preliminary review demonstrated a sufficient showing of interest to proceed toward an election.
- 3. On December 14, 2017 the Employer provided a copy of a unit employee list. That list showed that there were 11 employees in the unit confirming the preliminary finding of sufficiency.
- 4. On February 2, 2018 the parties entered into a Consent Election Agreement approved by the Executive Director and the Board and calling for an election February 16, 2018.
- 5. The election took place as called for in the Agreement immediately followed by a ballot count. The election results were: 11 ballots cast out of a total of 11 eligible voters. Therefore, more than 40% of the eligible voters cast ballots. 9, a majority of the ballots cast, were in favor of representation by the Union. 2 ballots were cast for "No Representation". Accordingly, after review by the PELRB at its March 6, 2018 meeting, the undersigned hereby certifies that the Union is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative for the unit described above.
