ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Public Employee Labor Relations Board (“NMPELRB”) on a disclaimer of any interest in further representation of employees of the New Mexico Motor Transportation Employees Association (“NMMTEA”) filed by the Fraternal Order of Police (“FOP”). A “Notice to Employees” was posted in an area frequented by employees from February 17, 2017 to March 3, 2017. The Notice informed employees that the FOP chose to relinquish representation of its employees and that employees may file objections to the relinquishment with the NMPELRB. No objections were received by the NMPELRB.

At its regularly scheduled meeting on April 25, 2017, Director Griego provided the Board with a copy of the Notice, email from the FOP seeking to disclaim any interest in the representation of NMMTEA employees and a letter from NMPELRB confirming FOP’s request to relinquish interest in representing FOP employees. The Board being sufficiently advised finds by a vote of 3-0 to:


- A. Ratify the disclaimer of interest by FOP in representing NMMTEA employees.

THEREFORE THE BOARD Orders Director Griego to publish this Order and enter the disclaimer of interest into the Board’s record.
