ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Public Employee Labor Relations Board on a Petition by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 18 ("Union") disclaiming interest as the bargaining unit representative for the City of Moriarty Police Department. The Board being sufficiently advised finds by a vote of 3-0 the following

1. Notice of relinquishment of representation by the Union was provided to City of Moriarty Police Department bargaining unit employees; and
2. No timely objections to the withdrawal of representation by the Union were received by the Public Employee Labor Relations Board.

THEREFORE THE BOARD recognizes the Union's disclaimer of interest as the incumbent labor organization for the City of Moriarty Police Department.
