**THIS MATTER** comes before the Public Employee Labor Relations Board at its regularly scheduled meeting on October 1, 2024, upon the Petition filed May 17, 2024, to amend the Certification of the bargaining unit to reflect the accretion of a new position of Security Aide within the existing bargaining unit. The Board, having reviewed the file, and being otherwise sufficiently informed, finds and concludes:

The Petition does not raise a question concerning representation and it presents sufficient facts including sufficient support among Security Aides to be represented by Petitioner pursuant to NMAC 11.21.2.38.

Upon review of the submissions and no one appearing in opposition to the Amended Certification, the Board by a vote of 3-0 hereby affirms and ratifies the Amended Certification of Representation issued by the Executive Director on August 7, 2024.

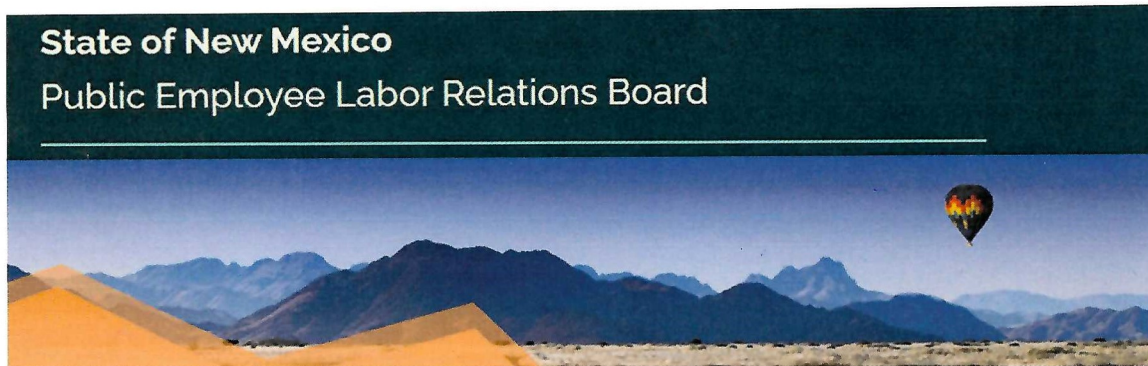

### **Amended Certification of Representation**

The undersigned hereby certifies that AFSCME Council 18, Local 2260, has demonstrated a sufficient basis pursuant to NMAC 11.21.2.38 to compel amendment of the certification of the bargaining unit comprising White Collar Bernalillo County employees it represents.


The undersigned makes this certification based on the following:

1. AFSCME Council 18, Local 2260, filed a Petition on May 17, 2024, requesting accretion of the position of Security Aide into an existing unit of White Collar employees.
2. On May 20, 2024, I determined that the Petition was facially valid and sent notice of the Petition requesting each parties' statement of their positions.
3. On June 4, 2024, the County Responded that the Petition unnecessarily excluded a Security Aide employed under the Sheriff's Office. That issue was resolved by mutual agreement of the parties at a Status and Scheduling Conference held August 6, 2024.
4. The Petition does not raise a question concerning representation and it presents sufficient facts pursuant including sufficient support among Security Aides to be represented by Petitioner pursuant to NMAC 11.21.2.38. Accordingly, certification of the bargaining unit shall be, and hereby is, amended to reflect its current description as follows:

Clerical & Technical Employees of Bernalillo County (White Collar Unit) including Administrative Assistant, Animal Care Services Communications Operator, Appraisal Technician, Assessor Technician I, Assessor Technician II, Assessor Technician Lead, Bureau Of Elections Technician, Clerical Specialist – Senior, Corrections Technician – MDC, Criminal Investigations Support Technician, Emergency Communications Operator, Emergency Communications Operator I, Emergency Communications Operator II, Housing Inspector I, Housing Inspector II, Housing Inspector III, Housing Program Assistant I, Housing Program Assistant II, Housing Program Assistant III, Metropolitan Detention Center Mail Processor, Micrographics Technician, , Probate Court Clerk Technician II, Records Management & Data Entry Technician, Records Management Specialist, Records Technician I, Records Technician II, Security Aide, Sheriff Administrative Support Technician, Social Services Coordinator, Solid Waste Account Specialist, and Tax Researcher.
