ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the Public Employee Labor Relations Board at its regularly scheduled meeting on June 3, 2025, upon the Petition by the Union to accrete the position of Warehouse Manager-Field Operations into the existing bargaining unit at the City of Farmington. The City did not contest the Warehouse Manager-Field Operations inclusion in the unit; and the Director found no unit composition issues or Questions Concerning Representation and that the Petition was supported by an adequate showing of interest.

Therefore, the Executive Director issued an Amended Certification on May 27, 2025 indicating the accretion of the Warehouse Manager-Field Operations position. Upon review of the submissions and no one appearing in opposition to the Amended Certification, the Board, by unanimous vote, hereby affirms and ratifies the Amended Certification of Representation issued by the Executive Director on May 27, 2025, including the findings therein.

The undersigned makes this certification based on the following:


1. **IBEW Local 611**, filed a Petition on May 16, 2025, requesting amendment of the Certification of the unit of **City of Farmington** employees represented by **IBEW Local 611**. (PELRB 312-25) On May 19, 2025, the Board's Executive Director determined that the Petition was facially valid and sent notice of the Petition requesting each parties' statement of their positions. Neither party raised any objection to the accretion.
2. The Petition does not raise a question concerning representation and was supported by a showing of interest indicating a majority of the employees to be accreted sought to be represented by the Petitioner. Accordingly, certification of the bargaining unit shall be, and hereby is, amended to reflect its current description as follows:
