ORDER

THIS MATTER comes before the Public Employee Labor Relations Board at its regularly scheduled meeting on October 7, 2025, upon a Petition by the union to accrete the position of Wildland Engine Boss into an existing bargaining unit at Valencia County. The Director found no unit composition issues or Questions Concerning Representation and that the Petition was supported by an adequate showing of interest. Therefore, the Executive Director issued an Amended Certification on September 29, 2025 indicating the accretion of the petitioned-for positions. Upon review of the submissions and no one appearing in opposition to the Amended Certification, the Board, by unanimous vote, hereby affirms and ratifies the Amended Certification of Representation issued by the Executive Director on September 29, 2025 including the findings therein.

Amended Certification of Representation

The undersigned makes this certification based on the following:

- 1. Valencia County Professional Firefighters Association, IAFF Local 5399, filed a Petition on August 21, 2025, requesting amendment of the Certification of the unit of Valencia County employees represented by Valencia County Professional Firefighters Association, IAFF Local 5399. (PELRB 327-25) On August 21, 2025, the Board's Executive Director determined that the Petition was facially valid and sent notice of the Petition requesting each parties' statement of their positions. Neither party raised any issues concerning representation.
- 2. The Petition does not raise a question concerning representation and it presents sufficient facts that the amendment should be made. Accordingly, certification of the bargaining unit shall be, and hereby is, amended to reflect its current description as follows:

EMS Specialists/Paramedics, Firefighters, Lieutenants, Battalion Commanders, Wildland Engine Boss, and Wildfire Captains employed by Valencia County in its Fire Department.
